BEFORE YOU DECIDE TO WITHDRAW FROM A COURSE...

Perhaps you are considering withdrawing from one of your courses – you didn't do too well on the test, missed a few classes, or are having trouble understanding the material. Before you decide to take the Withdrawal route, let me encourage you to try the following. You might be able to succeed in the course!

- Make an appointment to talk with your instructor and share your concerns. He/she can help you and would like to talk with you before you finalize your decision.
- Talk with your classmates about studying together outside of class.
- Attend the department's Tutorial/Help Sessions, if they have them. See the box to the right for times, days, and locations. If you need help in a department that is not listed, come by the OneStop, 2nd floor University Hall, to request a tutor for your class.
- GO TO CLASS!

HOW WITHDRAWALS *MAY* AFFECT YOUR CURRENT AND FUTURE ENROLLMENT STATUS:

- If Withdrawing causes you to be less than full-time, your current financial aid funding may be affected.
- Financial Aid policies require that you "successfully complete" 70% of your total attempted hours. Withdrawals may jeopardize your future financial aid funding eligibility.
- If you live in the Residence Hall, you are required to be actively enrolled in 12 hours or more.
- Having multiple **W** grades on your transcript is not the message you want to convey to future graduate schools and employers.
- **W** grades count in your attempted hours and may affect possible tuition surcharge and academic actions.
