## Before You Decide to Withdraw from a Class

Perhaps you are considering withdrawing from one of your courses - maybe you didn't do too well on the first test or paper, missed a few classes or assignments, and/or are having trouble understanding the material. Before you decide that the easiest solution is to Withdraw from the class, let me encourage you to consider some of the following strategies. With some additional work, you might be able to succeed in the course!

- Make an appointment to talk with your instructor. He/she would like to talk with you about your ability to succeed in the course before you make your decision.
- Get together with classmates outside of class to study and work together.
- Attend the department's tutorials (if available). The list to the right has days and times for departmental help sessions. If you need help in a department that is not listed, come by the OneStop, 2<sup>nd</sup> level – University Hall, to pick up a Peer-Tutor Request form.
- Go to class!

### ***How Withdrawals may affect your current and future enrollment status:***

- Financial Aid policies require that you “successfully complete” 70% of your attempted hours. Withdrawals may affect your future financial aid eligibility. For more, go to:

- Multiple **W** grades on your transcript are not a message that you want to send to prospective employers or graduate schools.

The NC General Assembly instituted a Tuition Surcharge, effective Fall 1994, on students attempting more than 140 hours for their degree. Currently, the Surcharge is 25% of Tuition; however, **effective Fall 2010, the Surcharge will be 50% of Tuition.** To read more, go to:
